

8 Easy Steps....to applying for a 14-16 Course at Exeter College

1

Find out about courses

Find out which courses are available through Exeter College from your school. Your school will give you an Options Booklet which will include all of the details.

2

Choose an Exeter College course on your Options Form

Once you've chosen which course you'd like to do, include this on your school options form. Your school will then let you know if you have chosen an appropriate course.

3

Attend our Taster Day

If your school agrees that an Exeter College course is appropriate for you, you can attend our Taster Day in March to find out what the course will be like and give you a chance to visit us at Exeter College. Your school will be able to make arrangements for you to attend the Taster Day. Once you've had a chance to find out more about the course at the Taster Day, you should decide for sure if you'd like to study this course as one of your options.

4

Complete your Exeter College application form

You will need to fill in an Exeter College application form, transition form and an interview task – all of these documents will be provided by your school.

5

Come along for an interview

We will send you a letter (through your school) inviting you for an informal interview with teaching staff in April. You will need to bring your completed application form, transition form and interview task with you and let us know if you have any additional support at school, so that we can make arrangements for you when you come to college. You will be able to ask questions about the course and studying at college and meet your college tutor.

6

Receive your offer

After your interview, you will receive confirmation of your place on the course from your school. If you have changed your mind about studying the course after your interview, you should let your school know as soon as possible.

7

Enrol on your course

You will be asked to enrol on your course at the college in July.

8

Start your course!!

From September you will start your new course with Exeter College!

N.B. Transport arrangements are different for each school; they will ensure you have all the correct details before you start your course.
